What I have learnt after these two days is that I could really look into the Sydney Harbour bridge, the Sydney Opera House and the colorful coral at the Great Barrier Reef.

Researchers found that between 1995 and 2017, the number of large, medium, and small corals in the 2,3000-kilometer-long coral

community along the Great Barrier Reef decreased by more than 50%. Studies have shown that record water temperature rises in 2016 and 2017 have led to large-scale bleaching of corals, which has a significant impact on the reduction of coral populations on the Great Barrier Reef. At the beginning of 2020, a large-scale bleaching phenomenon appeared on the Great Barrier Reef, and its impact has yet to be assessed.
